







The Award is given to a city that has demonstrated a wellestablished record of achieving high environmental standards and is committed to ongoing and ambitious goals.




















#### Ljubljana 2025 Vision (2007)




#### PRESERVING AND PROTECTING

- nature, biodiversity and green urban areas -
- 542 m² of public green areas per inhabitant
- 4 landscape parks (13,8 % of city area)
- More than 20 % of the area has nature protected status
- Forest covers 46 % of entire area of Ljubljana
- More than 80 ha of new green surfaces in the city







Landscape park Tivoli








The largest continuous green space (34 km long) Green Belt or "Path of Remembrance and Comradeship" with 7,000 trees









#### NO MORE CARS IN THE CITY CENTRE

- nature, biodiversity and green urban areas -

The pedestrian surfaces were increased by 620 % by closing the city centre for all motorized vehicles

The self-service bikesharing system Bicike(LJ) -> over 3 million rides in four years












## Urban ecological zone before - now












**Ecological zone: before and after** 








# Degraded land is changed into new parks and green areas





# Park Rakova jelša now connects the Ljubljana Marsh Nature Park with the city center






## THE LARGEST SHARE OF SEPARATE WASTE COLLECTION

- The Regional Waste Treatment Centre the largest cohesion and environmental project in the country
























